

Our ceremonies are based on the practical democracy of the Greeks under the League of Neighbors (Amphictyony) as practiced on the rugged island of Scio.

Legend tells that the island's inhabitants, the Sciots, sojourned to deliver the fruits of their native island to the Pharaoh of Egypt in about 1124 B.C., some sixty years after the fall of Troy.

Providing lodges within our district the resources to perform degrees which help grow the ranks of the Blue Lodges.




